

GOURGEN PAHLEVANYAN

GOURGEN PAHLEVANYAN was born in 1908 in Kars. He received primary education at the local school.

After graduating from the hydro-technical department of the Yerevan Polytechnic Institute in 1931 he started working in the water economy sector of the Republic.

In 1940 he was assigned Deputy People's Commissar of Water Industry of the Armenian SSR.

In 1947 he was assigned Minister of Municipal Economy of the Armenian SSR.

In 1953 Pahlevanyan was elected Second Secretary, and in May 1954 – First Secretary of the Yerevan City Committee of ACP.

In 1957-1960 he held the position of Chairman of the Executive Committee of the Yerevan City Council.

From 1961 to 1981 he was the head of Central Statistical Department of the Armenian SSR.

G. Pahlevanyan died in 1986.
