ASHOT GHAZARYAN

ASHOT GHAZARYAN was born in 1902 in Alexandrapol (at present Gyumri).

He started his career in 1917 at the local commandant's office and studied at the Trade College at the same time.

He combined his working career with his study at the Polytechnic Institute of Tiflis.

Between 1928 and 1932 he worked at "Dneproshin" (*Dnepropetrovsk construction*) in Leningrad, and then he moved



to Armenia and was appointed head of the "Kanakershin" (*Kanaker construction*) and director of the Hydropower Station of Kanaker.

In 1940 he was appointed director of the Yerevan Plant after Kirov, and then First Deputy Chairman of the Executive Committee of the Yerevan City Council.

In 1944 A. Ghazaryan was elected chairman of the Executive Committee of the Yerevan City Council.
