Must-Visit



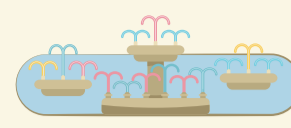
Matenadaran
Institute of Ancient Manuscripts is one of the world's biggest repositories of ancient manuscripts, research institute and museum.



Kond District
is one of the oldest residential districts where among the narrow streets is rapidly developing the street art.



Cascade Area
is the favourite location of locals for the best views on Yerevan (the higher you climb, the better are views) and Cafesjian Center for the Arts.



Singing Fountains
the dancing and singing fountains urge the locals and tourists to gather on the square and admire musical impressive show.



Blue Mosque
is a worth to visit Shia mosque on Mashtoc Avenue built in 1768.

Armenian Wine
throughout centuries wine has been the primary alcoholic drink in Armenia and the numerous ancient wine-pots found here approve Armenia is among oldest wine producing countries



Qghi
is homemade vodka with very high alcohol content made of grapes or other fruits, berries and blends.



Cocktails
you can always drink traditional Cosmopolitan but try special cocktails made with Armenian brandy and apricot to never forget Yerevanian nights.

Cascade area
Cascade is the place where the locals spend their evenings in numerous little cozy cafes no matter it's weekend or work day.



Saryan wine street
Saryan Street has become a line of places where you can enjoy large variety of wines from Armenia and many other wine producing countries both sitting on the street (until december) and inside.



Yerevan Zipline
Located near Davitashen bridge, the zipline is the longest in Armenia. The first line is about 870 meters long. The zipline passes under the bridge at 87-90 meters height.



Parks & Gardens
You can visit either the Baghramyan Street, where are located governmental gardens and famous Lovers' park, or The Tumo park, a perfect place for biking and picnics.



Taxi
In Yerevan taxi is quite cheap mean of transport so locals tend to use it every day.

Dolma
is meat mixed with rice and then rolled in grape leaves that is often called Armenian sushi.



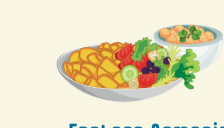
Khorovats

The water in Yerevan is very pure so you can drink it not only from faucet, but also from pulpulaks, public drinking water fountains.

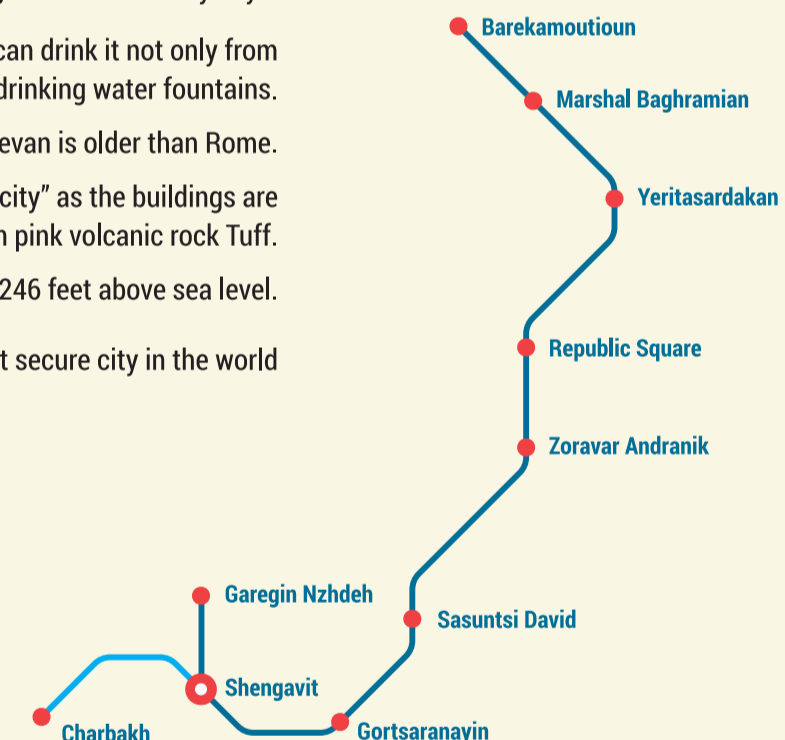
Yerevan is older than Rome.
