The proceeds of the loan and grant will not be used for the purpose of any payment to persons or entities, or for any import of goods, if such payment or import is prohibited by a decision of the United Nations Security Council taken under Chapter VII of the Charter of the United Nations or under a law of official regulation of the Purchaser's country.

Tendering for contracts is open to firms from any country.

Tendering for the above contract/s is expected to begin in the Q2 2023.
